RE: BECOMING A GOOD STEWARD IN 2014

Do you know what God expects of you?

Believe it or not, God has very definite plans for each one of us. He has blessed each of us with a unique set of gifts, skills, talents and resources so we can play a special role in building up the kingdom of God here on earth. To know God's plans for us, we simply need to pray:
